

Hockessin – Greenville Rotary Club
Current Dues, Fees, Breakfast Costs & Billing Procedures –2008

- **Initiation Fee** - \$70.00
- **Rotary Membership Dues** - \$120.00 per year

Dues are invoiced at \$30.00 per quarter. The dues is collected and paid to Rotary International and Rotary District 7630. Rotary District 7630 covers all of Delaware and Maryland's Eastern Shore.

- **Breakfast Meeting Costs** – Each meal is invoiced at a price of \$10.50 per meal and the quarterly member invoice is for meals in advance for that quarter.

For example – Rotary International and our club is on a fiscal year starting July 1st. Thus first quarter invoices would cover the months of July, August and September. If there were 12 Tuesday meetings held in that quarterly period the breakfast charges to the club member for that quarter would be - 12 meals X \$10.50 per meal or \$126.00.

- **The Rotary Foundation** – \$100 per year

Foundation contributions are invoiced at \$25.00 per quarter. Once a Club Member contributes \$1,000 or more to The Rotary Foundation or has that amount contributed to his or her name the club member is then recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow, and quarterly contributions to The Rotary Foundation are then optional. Additional contributions by members are encouraged and can be made at any time directly to the Rotary Foundation at the Member Access section of Rotary International's web site: www.rotary.org. The quarterly member invoice line item for this charge reads "*Paul Harris Sustaining Member Contribution*".

Club quarterly invoices are given to the member on or about the 15th day of January, April, July and October. The invoice includes quarterly dues, breakfast costs, contributions to The Rotary Foundation, and are reduced by any credits to the member's account. Invoices should be paid no later than 30 days after receipt.

Other Fees and Charges

- **Visiting Rotarians** – the cost for the breakfast meal for a Visiting Rotarian is \$11.00.
- **Visitors & Guests at Weekly Club Meetings** – Club Members are encouraged to bring guests to our weekly meetings. There is no breakfast cost for a guest of a Rotarian or visitor at our weekly meetings.
- **Fund Raising Events & Ticket Sales** – as voted upon by the Board of Directors for the full membership

Member Make Ups for Missed Meetings – Any missed regular club meeting can be made up within 14 days before or after that meeting at any Rotary Club. When traveling, club members are encouraged to visit Rotary clubs within that local area. A list of clubs can be found on the Rotary International web site using the Club Locator. The club you visit will give you a credit receipt when you check in with the greeter. The signed receipt is given to the Club Treasurer by the member at the next club meeting. The Club Treasurer will then credit the member's account and a breakfast credit of \$10.50 which will be deducted from the member's next quarterly invoice for each make up that has been submitted.
